

Documents Required to Obtain a Driver License

DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS (photo copies are not acceptable)

- Surrender current/vailed driver's license
- U.S. certified birth certificate, valid U.S. passport/passport card, certificate of citizenship/naturalization, valid permanent resident card, valid employment authorization document, or foreign passport with U.S. visa/I-94).
- Second document proving identity (such as social security card, W-2 form or 1099).
- You will also need to provide a receipt from a South Dakota hotel/motel, campground, or RV park to prove one night of stay within the current year and ONE DOCUMENT (no more than one year old) proving your personal mailbox (PMB) service address (receipt from the PMB business or a piece of mail with your PMB address on it).
- If you are using a South Dakota mail forwarding address, you will need to complete the residency affidavit.

***If your name has changed, you will need to provide documented proof of the name change (marriage certificate, divorce decree, or court order).**
